With the TowneBank Shamrock 8K on Saturday and the Yuengling Shamrock Marathon and Anthem Shamrock Half Marathon on Sunday, runners can also complete the Dolphin Challenge (8K and Half Marathon) or Whale Challenge (8K and Marathon).

The mix of great racing, fun festivities, and beautiful scenery likely explains the race's popularity. More than 20,000 finishers—plus 2,000 volunteers—took part in the 2019 series, with folks coming from all 50 states. That included T. Wooten, who raved about the weekend's allure for community.
